THE TOWER

A PROUD HISTORY

Nestled in the Rhigos mountain range, The Tower is situated at the old Tower Colliery coal mining site. It was the oldest continuously working deep-coal mine in the United Kingdom, and possibly the world, until its closure in 2008. This was the last mine of its kind in the South Wales valleys.


A drift mine that increased from 1805, until in 1864 the first drift named Tower was started. It was named after the nearby Crawshay's Tower, a folly built in 1848 and named after Richard Crawshay, a London iron merchant and one of ten known British millionaires in 1799. In 1941, a new shaft known as Tower No.4, was sunk to a depth of 160 metres. It was used for transporting manpower only and in 1945 there were 1,045 men working at Tower.

CEGIN GLO

Our Bar & Bistro name, pronounced 'Keg-in Glorr', is Welsh for 'Coal Kitchen', chosen for its nod to the site's former use, blending with the new era – this was chosen by a resident local to Zip World Tower, Paul Williams.
